Professor Theodore M. Shaw is the Julius L. Chambers Distinguished Professor of Law and Director of the Center for Civil Rights at the University of North Carolina School of Law at Chapel Hill. Professor Shaw was the fifth Director-Counsel and President of the NAACP Legal Defense and Educational Fund, Inc., for which he worked in various capacities over the span of twenty-six years. He received a B.A. with Honors from Wesleyan University in 1976. He earned a J.D. from Columbia Law School in 1979, where he was a Charles Evans Hughes Fellow.
